Education and Training	Minimum of 15 clock hours per year of relationship-based education and training, pertaining to the promotion of social-emotional development and/or the

	practice of infant mental health (e.g., regional training, related course work at colleges or universities, infant mental health conference attendance). For those who earn endorsement at Level III and provide reflective supervision or consultation, at least 3 of the hours of specialized training must be about reflective supervision or consultation. Documentation of training hours submitted with membership renewal.

Education and Training	Minimum of 15 clock hours per year of relationship-based education and training, pertaining to the promotion of social-emotional development and/or the practice of infant mental health (e.g., regional training, related course work at colleges or universities, infant mental health conference attendance). For those who earn endorsement at Level IV-Clinical and provide reflective supervisor or consultation to others, it is recommended that at least 3 of the hours of specialized training be about reflective supervision or consultation. Documentation of training hours submitted with membership renewal.
